

How to get to NWOC:

Heading south over the Aurora Bridge, take the Dexter exit. Head south (right) on Dexter to Garfield. Left on Garfield a block to bottom of hill and a tee, take a right, go 1/2 block to light (Westlake), take a left and come up to the stoplight at Crockett St, turn right into the parking lot. We are below Seattle Changing Room and Julie's Landing, which has a clocktower with a flag.

Heading North on Aurora from downtown, turn Right on Aloha, go down 2 blocks to 8th, turn left, then left onto Westlake, come up a mile to the stoplight at Crockett St, turn right into the parking lot. We are below Seattle Changing Room and Julie's Landing, which has a clocktower with a flag.

From I-5 North or South: Take Mercer St exit, at bottom of exit get in far right hand lane, at Westlake, turn right, come up a mile to the stoplight at Crockett St just past the big black tile building (China Harbor), turn right into the parking lot. We are below Seattle Changing Room and Julie's Landing, which has a clocktower with a flag.

From Fremont: Go South over the Fremont Bridge, left on Westlake just after the bridge. Go about a mile to the 1st stoplight, turn left into the parking lot. We are below Seattle Changing Room and Julie's Landing, which has a clocktower with a flag.

From UW, or Burke Gillman (walking, bus or bike): The #31 or #32 bus takes you to Fremont, and you can transfer to #40 which stops out front of our shop, or walk over the bridge and about a mile south to our shop. The Burke Gillman Trail will take you over the Fremont Bridge. After you cross the bridge, the safest way to go is on the bike or walking path on the left (east) side. Driving, go West on 45th or 50th to Stone Way, South on Stone to 34th, right on 34th, take a left (South) on Fremont Ave, over the Fremont Bridge, left on Westlake just after the bridge. Go about a mile to the 1st stoplight, turn left into the parking lot. We are below Seattle Changing Room and Julie's Landing, which has a clocktower with a flag.

From Downtown Seattle: The 40 bus stops out front, at the stoplight at Crockett St, just after China Harbor, the big black tile building. There are other buses that stop on Dexter and Aurora up the hill from us. When you get off the bus, look towards the lake, and you will see a kayak standing on end next to our stairway, below Seattle Changing Room and Julie's Landing, which has a clocktower with a flag.
